They have dedicated staff and resources to ensure the success of R4HA and research system development in their countries. NEPAD brings regional political expertise to the partnership, helping to build inter-country cooperation through links to Regional Economic Communities and other relevant African bodies. COHRED draws on its expertise in research system building including priority setting; policy development, governance structures for research and web-based platforms for knowledge sharing and collaboration (HRWeb, Research Ethics Web) both in Africa and elsewhere to provide the technical support and facilitation needed to achieve the optimum impact of research investment on health and development.
